Church is open daily for private prayer.

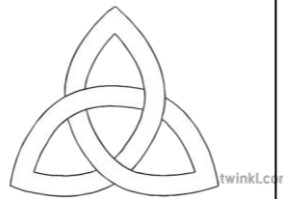
