#### Dear Parishioner,

I write to inform you that from this summer, the parish of Caherdaniel will no longer have a priest resident in the parish. Each of the priests in the Iveragh pastoral area will now minister to the parish of Caherdaniel with one priest taking the lead role as Moderator. Caherdaniel will continue to be a separate parish and will continue to have the fullness of parish life.

In the coming months the Diocesan Pastoral Team will guide and support the parish and pastoral area through this time of transition. While the decrease in the number of clergy in the diocese is regrettable, there is a positive dimension to this new reality. It provides an opportunity for laity to take their rightful place in leadership roles in all our parishes.

Due to the commitment of clergy and laity and the preparation that has been underway throughout the diocese at parish and pastoral area level, I believe Caherdaniel parish and the Iveragh pastoral area will adjust well.

I offer you, the people and the priests of the Iveragh pastoral area, my support at this time. I will keep you in my prayers as you strive to respond to this new situation.

I regret that this news comes to you as Covid-19 continues to to cause great difficulties. May the completion of the vaccination program make a real difference. May God watch over us all with his Fatherly care.
