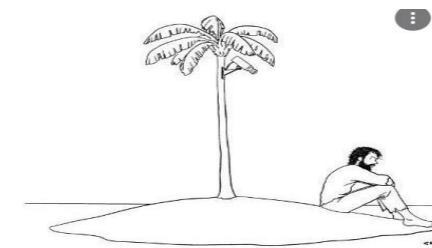
Churches are open daily for private prayer.
