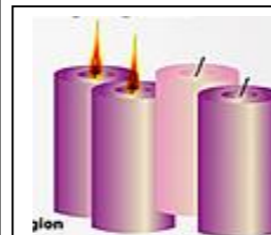

The four candles, three purple and one pink, represent the four weeks of Advent during which we reflect on the themes of Hope, Love, Joy & Peace.
