Habemus Papam? Praying for a Sainly Succesor

The process of choosing a new Pope is called a conclave, from the Latin cum clave, meaning 'with a key', since the cardinals are literally locked in until a decision is made, a tradition going back to 1274. Held in the Sistine Chapel in Vatican City, the conclave gathers all cardinals under the age of 80. They pray, discern, discuss & vote in secret, needing a two-thirds majority to elect a new Pope. White smoke from the chapel's chimney signals to the world: HABEMUS PAPAM! We have a Pope.
